IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL AMO MEDICAL PLAN PARTICIPANTS

June 28, 2006

The AMO Medical Plan has been notified that participants of the Medical Plan may have or will receive a notice from Medical Excess, LLC (“Medical Excess”) advising that personal data, such as name, social security number and birthdate, may have been included on a file of stolen equipment removed from one of its regional offices. Your AMO Medical Plan data on file at the Plan office has not been stolen or misused.

It has been reported that the theft took place on March 31, 2006 and included laptop computers, a music CD player, a camcorder and a file server. The reports state that access to the data required a user name and was password protected. It was also reported that it appears that the thieves were not focused on the data but rather on the physical hardware that was stolen.

By law, notice of such thefts is required to be sent to all those potentially affected and is a precautionary measure. Medical Excess has advised that no information to date has surfaced to suggest that any of the personal information has been used.

Medical Excess is a member company of American International Group, Inc. (AIG), which provides reinsurance coverage and stop-loss coverage to health plans. These excess coverage policies are used by health plans in the event of catastrophic illness or injuries to protect both you and the Plan. Data obtained by Medical Excess is used for the purpose of potentially providing stop-loss excess insurance coverage for AMO Medical Plan participants.

The notice sent by Medical Excess is an informational measure and makes recommendations on how to protect yourself and your personal information, and how to contact Medical Excess if you believe any of your information has been misused. Please read the notice and follow the directions and recommendations presented. In the event that you notice and/or experience any misuse of any of your personal information, you should contact Medical Excess immediately. The Plan office is reviewing the situation and will provide more information as it becomes available.
